Incorporating Gentle Scar Tissue Mobilization into Your Oncology Massage

Surgery and radiation are standard aspects of cancer diagnosis and treatment. As a result, it is not rare for our oncology massage clients to be living with at least one, if not many, scars. This workshop will prepare you to employ safe, simple and non-invasive techniques in a limited, but highly effective way. These techniques, inspired by the work of Jamie Elswick and Nancy Keeney Smith (author of *Traumatic Scar Tissue Management*), can be incorporated into any massage session to aid in scar tissue remodeling and improved range of motion, as well as local flow of blood and lymph. This workshop is open to and appropriate for therapists both with and without MLD training.
