

National Massage Therapist Listing Terms & Conditions

To be eligible for the National Massage Therapist Listing (NMTL), the terms & conditions are as follows:

- As an OML-trained Massage Therapist, you must have passed both of the Oncology Massage Module 2 (OM2) assessments, and received your certificate
- You must read and sign the OML Code of Practice for Therapists, and then return it to us with your annual registration form and payment
- You must currently be in practice and accepting new clients, with reasonably short waiting periods
- You must attend at least one relevant continuing education course every 12-18 months to maintain your listing. The list of appropriate and approved programs can be found in "Staying Current with OML"
- You must maintain membership of your preferred professional association, and therefore your insurance. This association membership will be noted on your Listing
- You should keep OML aware of any changes to your professional or contact details

OML reserves the right to deny access to this listing to any Massage Therapist who does not abide by the Code of Practice for Therapists or any of the responsibilities listed above Terms and Conditions.
